

Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) - An Easy Way to Make Your Gift

The Wisconsin Province has added a convenient way for you to make your contributions. In addition to paying by check or credit card, we also offer Electronic Contribution.

Q: What is Electronic Contribution?

A: Electronic Contribution automatically transfers money from your personal bank account to the Wisconsin Province without writing checks. It is similar to automatic withdrawal.

Q: What are the advantages of Electronic Contribution?

A: It saves you time! It simplifies your life! No checks to write! No envelope to mail!

Q: How is my contribution automatically deducted from my account?

A: Once you authorize - in writing - the transfer, your contribution is deducted from your checking or savings account and electronically credited to the Wisconsin Province's account.

Q: When will my contribution be deducted from my account?

A: Your contribution will be deducted on the dates you specify.

Q: If I don't write checks, how do I keep my checkbook balance straight?

A: Since your contribution is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

Q: Without a canceled check, how can I prove I made my contribution?

A: Your bank statement gives you an itemized list of electronic transfers. It's your proof of contribution, as well as an acknowledgement letter from the Wisconsin Province.

Q: Is Electronic Contribution risky?

A: Electronic Contribution involves less risk than using a check. It can't be lost, stolen or destroyed in the mail, and it has an extremely high rate of accuracy.

Q: What if I change bank accounts?

A: The Wisconsin Province will provide a new authorization form for the new bank and new account number. The old transfer authorization is terminated.

Q: How much does Electronic Contribution cost?

A: It costs you nothing.

Q: Do I need to have a computer to use Electronic Contribution?

A. No. Once your authorization form is completed we handle the transactions for you.

Q: What if I try Electronic Contribution and don't like it?

A: You can cancel your authorization for electronic contribution at any time by notifying the Wisconsin Province Development office in writing.

A: Click here to download the authorization form. Mail the completed form along with a copy of the required document (a voided check if using your checking account or a saving deposit slip if using your savings account) to:
